HOW DOES THIS WORK?

- onCommit:
 - Record diffable representations of data (like library version)
 - Record lots of shas
- onPush:
 - Provide diff events to drive nudges



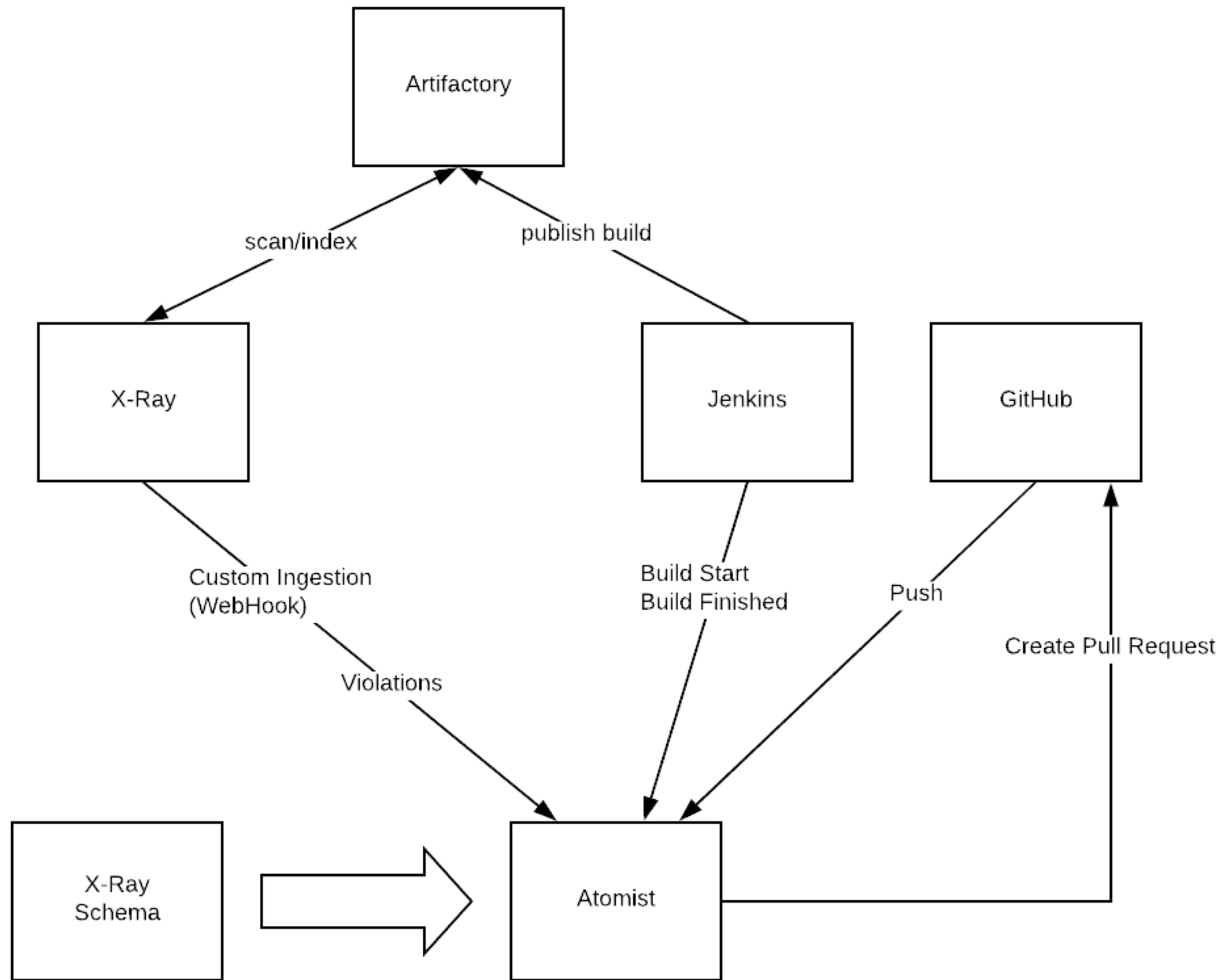

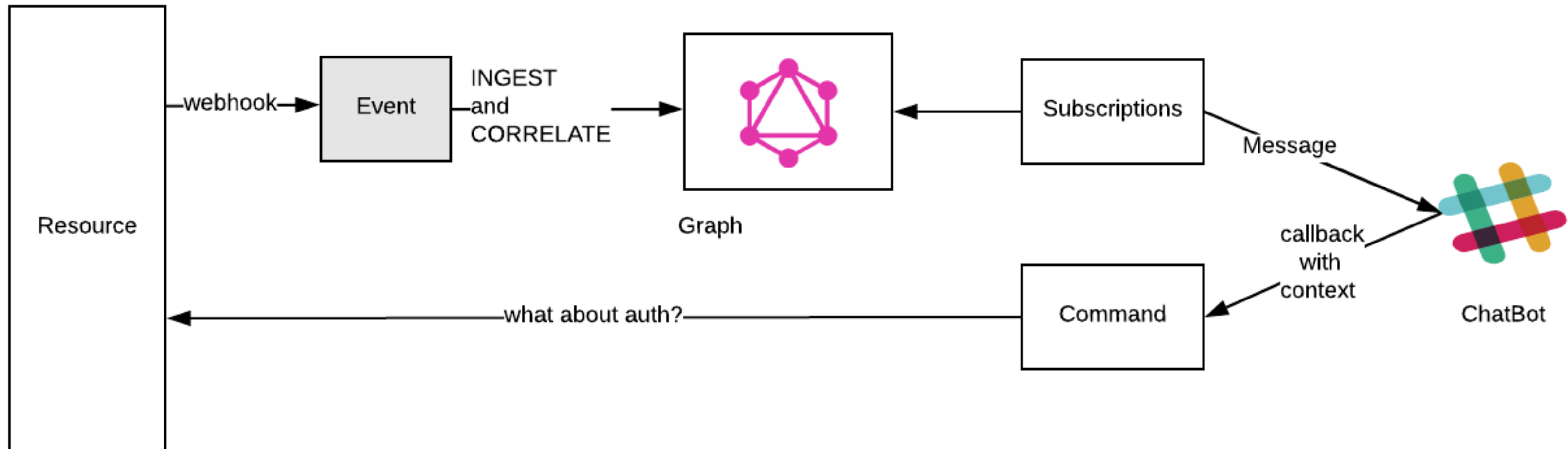
Orient: some projects are affected

SUMMARY

- Predict when a command is relevant and present it in context
- Make it easy to do the things that align with your values
- Always be learning
 - New projects should not be hard to start
 - Lower the barrier for trying things
 - Lower the barrier for good ideas spreading
- Bots
 - not mobile CLIs
 - Agents to facilitate collaboration
 - Automate in a social context
